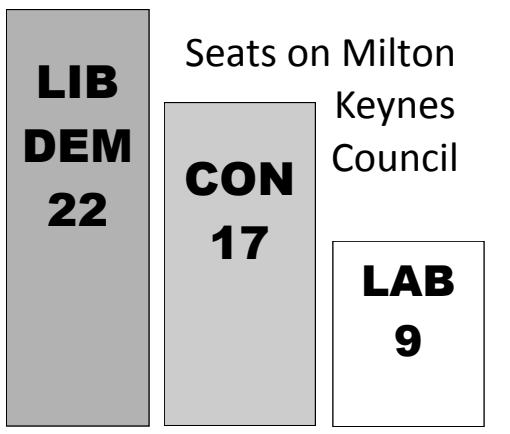
NEW BLUE BINS

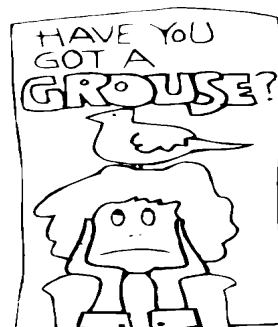
